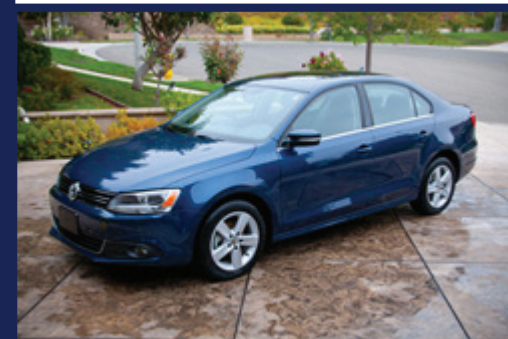

Call us!

Drawing on our Provider Alliance, we will help you determine the ride that's right for you.

- We will listen and help you establish your needs.
- We will discuss service options from our Provider Alliance that may meet your needs.
- If no other service is available, we can connect you with one of our own *Rides For Ridgefield* volunteer drivers.
- We will register you and have you sign our Rider Agreement.

Rides' own volunteer drivers

Rides For Ridgefield's volunteer drivers may be available to drive you to your destination when no other service fits your needs.

What to expect when you call our Call Center

Our Call Center volunteer will ask you for some information:

- Your name
- Contact information
- Any limitations you may have accessing a vehicle
- Any medical equipment you may take when you go out
- Do we have a signed Rider Agreement on file for you

Be prepared before you call

We will need some details about your trip:

- Purpose of your trip
- Appointment location or desired destination
- Pick-up or appointment time
- Estimated length of visit
- Return time
