Rides For Ridgefield provides information and rides for seniors and residents with mobility disabilities (permanent or temporary). The organization functions through a Mobility Management Center staffed by volunteers and located at Ridgefield Town Hall. The center provides:

- a single source for Ridgefield ride information;
- counseling for seniors and residents with mobility disabilities regarding transportation needs and available options;
- a centralized reservation assistance service;
- a volunteer ride service

Eligibility: Ridgefield residents 60 and older and residents with mobility disabilities.
